Street Light Request

Requests for residential street lights may be submitted to the Charlotte County Lighting District. Upon receipt of a request, an inspection will be conducted of the area to determine if the proposed location meets **all four criteria** set forth by the Board of County Commissioners. The following four criteria must be present before a request for a street light can be granted.

- 1. The proposed residential street light must be at least 300 feet from an existing residential street light and**
- 2. A direct source of electrical power is readily available at the proposed location and**
- 3. The proposed street light will benefit at least three dwellings in a cluster (across the street, next door, etc.) and**
- 4. The requester must live in the immediate vicinity of the proposed street light location.**

Requests for street lights are received through the online form (below). A Charlotte County staff member will contact the requester after a field inspection has been completed to notify the requester if the proposed location meets all four criteria. Field inspections are conducted in the order that requests are received. If all four criteria are met, the Charlotte County Lighting District will request that **Florida Power & Light** or **Lee County Electric Cooperative** install the residential street light.
