A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CHARLOTTE COUNTY, FLORIDA TO AMEND RESOLUTION 2006-171, PROVIDING FOR REVISED FEES FOR THE ISSUANCE OF ANIMAL LICENSE CERTIFICATES AND TAGS AND DUPLICATE OR REPLACEMENT TAGS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, Section 828.27, Florida Statutes, authorizes the Board of County Commissioners (hereinafter "Board") to enact ordinances relating to animal control, and;

WHEREAS, Chapter 1-4, Article II, Animal Control, of the Code of Laws and Ordinances of Charlotte County, Florida authorizes the Board to establish fees related to services provided by Charlotte County Animal Control; and

WHEREAS, the Board adopted Ordinance 98-70 providing for animal license certificates and tags; and

WHEREAS, the Board adopted Resolution 98-129 to establish fees for animal license certificates and tags and duplicate or replacement tags; and

WHEREAS, the Board adopted Resolution 2006-171 amending Resolution 98-129 and providing for revised fees for animal license certificates and tags and duplicate or replacement tags; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to a request by Charlotte County Animal Control, the Board now desires to further amend the fees for animal license certificates and tags and duplicate or replacement tags as contained in Resolution 2006-171.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Charlotte County, Florida:

1. Resolution 2006-171 is hereby amended to reflect the following fees for issuance of license certificates and tags and duplicate or replacement tags:

Any animal 1-year of age or under: \$12.00
Any unaltered animal 1-year of age or older: \$30.00
Any altered animal 1-year of age or older: \$12.00
Any duplicate or replacement tag: one-half of the above fee

At the time these fees are collected, the veterinary entity issuing the license certificates and tags shall retain \$2.00 from each fee payment and the remainder shall be distributed to Charlotte County Animal Control.

2. The remainder of Resolution 2006-171 shall remain in full force and effect.

3. This Resolution shall take effect upon approval by the Board and such fees shall remain in effect until changed by the Board.
