**6 BACKGROUND ( Why is this Action Necessary, and What Action will be accomplished )**

## ECONOMIC IMPACT ESTIMATE

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CHARLOTTE COUNTY, FLORIDA; ABOLISHING THE ROTONDA WHITE MARSH STREET AND DRAINAGE MUNICIPAL SERVICE BENEFIT UNIT.

**PURPOSE:** Analyze what the Ordinance is designed to accomplish. Describe the present situation and the effect the Ordinance will have thereon.

This Ordinance would abolish and repeal the Rotonda White Marsh Street and Drainage Municipal Service Benefit Unit (Unit) Ordinance. The purpose of the Unit is to provide for the construction, reconstruction, repair, paving, draining, etc. of streets and drainage facilities in the Unit. Because the Unit's paving program has been completed, and the loan has been paid in full, staff is recommending that the Unit be abolished. Since the territory of the Unit is part of the Rotonda West Street and Drainage MSBU, any street and drainage work needed will be funded by the Rotonda West Street and Drainage MSBU.

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AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CHARLOTTE COUNTY, FLORIDA; ABOLISHING THE ROTONDA WHITE MARSH STREET AND DRAINAGE MUNICIPAL SERVICE BENEFIT UNIT; REPEALING ORDINANCE 97-011 AS CODIFIED IN CHAPTER 4-6, ARTICLE XLVI, SECTIONS 4-6-951 THROUGH 4-6-957, OF THE CODE OF LAWS AND ORDINANCES, CHARLOTTE COUNTY, FLORIDA; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the Charlotte County Board of County Commissioners ( the "Board"), pursuant to the provisions of Section 125.01, Florida Statutes, has the power to establish, merge or abolish municipal service benefit units and levy and collect assessments within such units; and

WHEREAS, the Board, on March 25, 1997, adopted Ordinance No. 97-011, which established the Rotonda White Marsh Street and Drainage municipal service benefit unit (Unit); and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Unit is to provide for the construction, reconstruction, paving, draining, etc. of streets and drainage facilities in the Unit; and

WHEREAS, since the Unit's paving programs have been completed, county staff is recommending that the Unit be abolished and that Ordinance No. 97-011 which created this Unit be repealed and that any future street and drainage maintenance work needed be funded by the Rotonda West Street and Drainage MSBU; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Board of County Commissioners to abolish the Rotonda White Marsh Street and Drainage Unit and repeal Ordinance No. 97-011.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of  
2 Charlotte County, Florida that:

3 Section 1. The Rotonda White Marsh Street and Drainage Unit is hereby abolished  
4 and Ordinance No. 97-011, as codified in Chapter 4-6, Article XLVI, Sections 4-6-951  
5 through 4-6-957, of the Code of Laws and Ordinances, Charlotte County, Florida, is hereby  
6 repealed in its entirety.

7 Section 2. Effective Date. A certified copy of this Ordinance shall be filed with the  
8 Department of State of the State of Florida by the Clerk of the Board of County  
9 Commissioners within 10 days of enactment and shall take effect upon filing with said  
10 department.
