## PROCLAMATION

**WHEREAS**, on January 8, 1964 President Lyndon B. Johnson announced his “War on Poverty” by introducing legislation that would provide the opportunity for federal, state and local government to take an active role in poverty reduction efforts; and

**WHEREAS**, The Economic Opportunity Act was designed to give economic opportunity for all by creating the national effort to fight poverty at the local level, and Charlotte County Human Services was then designated as the local Community Action Agency on May 19, 1998; and

**WHEREAS**, in this local effort to fight poverty, the Community Action Agency has made essential contributions to individuals and families in Charlotte County by providing people with innovative, cost-effective, and outcome-based programming to provide economic opportunity for those in need; and

**WHEREAS**, in our local service delivery area, we vow, today and in the future, to continue to fight to eliminate poverty by providing needed education, training, jobs, support, and opportunities for citizens in need of assistance to help them build ladders of opportunity in their personal desire to achieve self-sufficiency.
