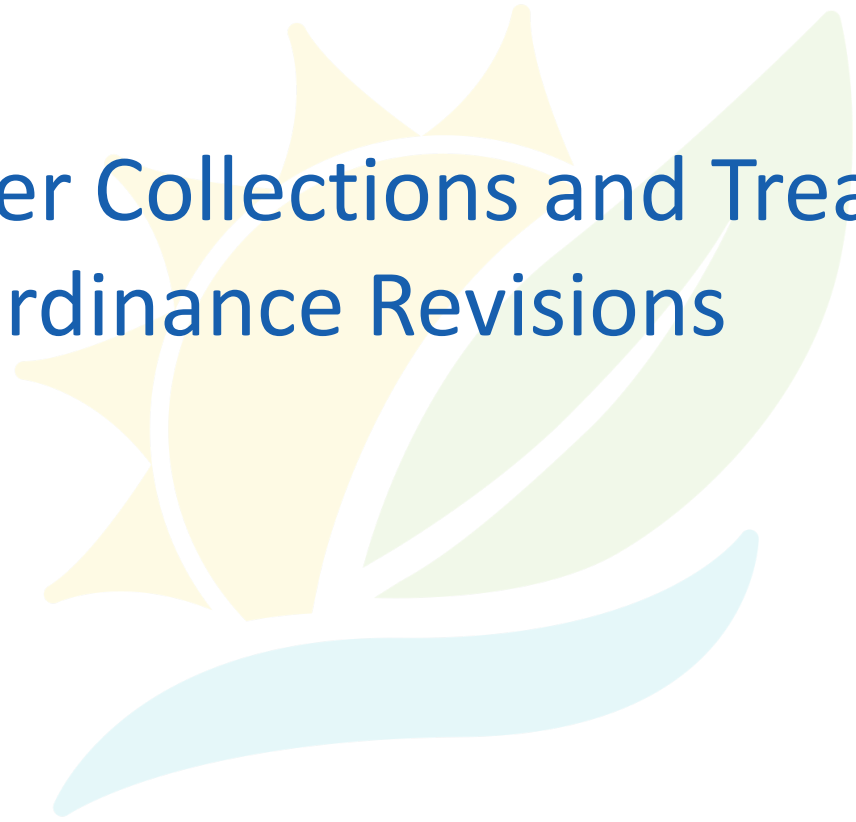

Chapter 3-8 - Water and Sewer

Article V

- The County Ordinance was last updated 2001.
- This is being done to comply with any updated or new applicable State laws or Federal regulations in accordance with:
 - The Clean Water Act (33 United States Code 1251 seq)
 - Florida Administrative Code (Chapter 62)
 - Code of Federal Regulations (40 CFR)

Major Revisions to Article V

by Division

- **Division 1**
 - Updated Definitions.
 - Added new section concerning Infiltration / Inflow.
- **Division 2**
 - Added Title (no previous division 2).
 - Updated Sec. 3-8-123 to include Dental Office Point Source Category.
 - Raised Maximum Concentration limits, since monitoring reports will be more frequent.
 - CBOD 200 to 250 mg/L
 - COD 400 to 450 mg/L
 - TSS 250 to 300 mg/L
 - Chlorides 300 to 400 mg/L
- **Division 4**
 - Changed permit renewal from 1 year to not to exceed 5 years.

Major Revisions to Article V

by Division

- Division 5
 - Changed Rates, Fees, and Fines to be addressed by a resolution.
- Division 6
 - Updated Section 3-8-150 to comply with FAC 62-625.
 - Added monitoring requirements and monitoring reports to industrial users.
 - Industrial users' requirement to notify CCU & FDEP of hazardous waste discharge to CCU facilities.
- Division 7 & 8 Combined

Revisions to Article V

- Entire Article V
 - Deleted obsolete information.
 - Removed maximum concentration limit specific to each facility.
 - Removed section concerning search warrants.
 - Removed enforcement section.
 - Clarified and consolidated sections.
 - Moved all definitions into Division 1
