

CHARLOTTE COUNTY EMERGENCY ORDER NO. 2017-

AN ORDER LIFTING THE EMERGENCY ORDER PROHIBITING THE SALE OF ALCOHOL AND THE CURFEW BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 9PM to 6AM DURING THE DECLARED STATE OF EMERGENCY FOR HURRICANE IRMA

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Charlotte County, Florida issued a Resolution declaring a state of local emergency, dated September 5, 2017; and thereafter extended it on September 12, 2017 for another seven (7) days to September 19, 2017.

WHEREAS, the Resolution, in accordance with Chapters 252 and 870, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 2-1 of the Charlotte County Code of Ordinances, authorizes the County and the Sheriff to take all necessary action and issue any necessary orders to protect human life and property; and

WHEREAS, to ensure the protection of life and property, the County and the Sheriff jointly issued Emergency Order 2017-70 imposing a 9PM to 6AM curfew within Charlotte County, among other things; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the improved situation within Charlotte County due to significant recovery efforts, the County Administrator, the County's Public Safety Emergency Manager and the Charlotte County Sheriff have recommended ending the curfew and prohibition on alcohol sales; and


NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby ordered:

Section 1. Section 1 of Emergency Order 2017-70 prohibiting the sale of alcoholic beverages within the geographic boundaries of Charlotte County is hereby rescinded effective this date.






